What is the Swiss LGBTI Label?

The Swiss LGBTI Label is a quality mark awarded to organizations in Switzerland that actively promote diversity, equality, and fair opportunities for LGBTI people at work. The process is based on clear and verifiable criteria and is supported scientifically by the University of Bern and the Bern University of Applied Sciences (BFH). It reviews key dimensions such as internal policies, leadership accountability, HR and recruitment practices, inclusive communication, and employee networks. Organizations that are awarded the label demonstrate a structured and lasting approach to fostering inclusion.

Since its launch in 2019, over 100 organizations have been awarded the label. Today, 80 hold the label and actively participate in the growing network, representing a wide spectrum of industries and institutional sectors. The label is valid for three years.

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
